Description: A dingo – light armoured Car, manned by the men who served in the middle east before coming to Burma. Sitting on the observers seat is Brigadeir Captain Jenkins HQ 7<sup>th</sup> Armoured Brgade.

This car was reputedly issued to the 1<sup>st</sup> Queen Victoria Rifles as part of the BEF 1940 and was presumably evacuated to Great Britain before being sent to Burma.
